

Japanese government has announced a "Fixed Amount Tax Reduction" known as "Teigaku Genzei (定額減稅)".

Individuals will receive a 30,000yen-income tax reduction and a 10,000yen local inhabitant tax.

If your income or local taxes are lower than the "Tax Cut" level, you will not be eligible for the benefit.

The Japanese government also announced cash aid for low-income individuals.

## [1] 70,000yen in financial aid for households exempt from paying local inhabitant tax.

Cash aid of **30,000yen has already been delivered** to low-income households in 2023, in many cities. In addition, 70,000yen will be delivered to households exempt from paying local inhabitant tax in 2024. In this case, your eligibility is determined by your annual income in **2022**.

[2] 100,000yen in financial aid, for households paying the minimal local inhabitant tax. Additionally, 50,000yen will be delivered to each dependent child.

Low-income households that did not apply for Case 1 will receive a cash aid of 100,000 yen. In this case, eligibility is based on your annual income in **2022**.

## [3] 100,000yen in financial aid, for low-income households

In this case, the eligibility is determined by your annual income in 2023.

The specifics are the same as the cases [1] and case [2].

## [4] Cash aid for those whose income or local taxes fall below the "Fixed Amount Tax Reduction" threshold.

In this case, the eligibility depends on your annual income in 2023.

The amount of Cash Aid depends on the difference between your real income or local tax and the fixed amount of tax reduction.
